<p>NOTES:</p>	<p>2/16 SLT meeting notes</p> <p>Stakeholder and committee report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There was nothing new to report today. <p>Unfinished Business:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Discussed student's extracurricular activities. ● The students visited the restaurant twice so far. (Mrs. Welsh brought up the point about the criteria used to choose students for the restaurant visits. Dr. Hislop shared that students were chosen based on cafeteria behavior. We further discussed that students should be selected based on their overall behavior. Mrs. Welch would draft a new letter that would have the new criteria for the luncheon. ● Dr. Hislop shared that they have paid for one school trip to Philadelphia so far. ● Dr. Hislop stated that they were pooling resources to refurbish or repurpose the teachers lounge and create a sensory walk for pre K. ● Currently we are doing a deeper dive on standards that students are not performing proficiently on the test. ● We currently have Math and ELA consultants and Dr. Drucker who are working with the school. <p>New Business:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Brainstormed ideas to improve students stamina. It was discussed that there needs to be a mindset shift for the school to increase students' stamina. There should be an initiative to do it all year long, not only for the test . ● Dr. Hislop spoke about building relationships and meeting with the new social worker to discuss ways in which to build and improve relationships. ● Mrs. Welch stated that the Paraprofessional Luncheon will be held on March 3rd. The cost will be \$25. (Individuals who would like to attend, will have to sign up and inform the SLT. They will be given a purchase order to take as payment. There will be workshops given but they will have to pay those fees.)
