Stakeholder and committee report-

- There were no stakeholder or committee reports to share today.

BOY Data:

- Data shows that students in the yellow have knowledge from the previous year. They are at the baseline beginning.
- Students in the green show knowledge of a little of grade level
- Green with lines show above grade level knowledge.
- 48 % are on track to meet standard
- As we go up in grade levels, the students below grade level increases (Ms. Hislop asked for suggestions to move data)
- In math, 44% are on pace to grade level.
- Ms. Sealy questioned whether or not other data studies have been done besides by the iReady company itself, that shows that iReady works and is effective in moving students.
- Mr. Mack looked through What Works Clearing House to see if there were any he could find, and found none.

Suggestions:

- Ms. Edmond suggested exposing students to iReady for language familiarity (sometimes students don't know the language, it's not necessarily that they don't know the work).
- Make a conscious effort to put students on to iReady during the day.

Concerns:

- Ms. Sealy stated that books are needed for centers
- Mr. Mack stated that the school cannot afford to buy both ReadyNy and Measuring up if it's only going to be used for centers.
- Ms. Edmond don't suggest buying ReadyNy because it can be printed from the computer for lessons that you want.

SLT Bylaws:

- The team needs to vote on whether or not we want to hold meetings virtual. We need feedback from parent members before finalizing the decision.
- For those who want to attend, District SLT webinar at 6pm tomorrow.

Principal Hislop Concerns:

- Concerned with lunchroom setting.
- Would like to have etiquette training (eating, table setting, cleanliness of table and floor)
- Wants students to learn etiquette. Would like to set up a table once a week. Special kids selected.
- Lunch room needs to look better. It needs a makeover. Ms. Hislop stated that she reached out to Success Academy to partner and received no response.

Parent Communication Platform:

- This year we do not have Skedula.
- We need a way to record student behavior and anecdotes to communicate to parents.
- Ms. Hislop is looking into the platform Kickboard which has needed features

- > preselected behaviors
- > parents see in real time
- > every teacher can see information for every child
- > two way communication between school and parents
- > Students earn 59 dollars for positive behaviors.

Staff Concern:

- Staff members complained that the ladies staff bathroom on the second floor, used by both PS 59 and Success Academy staff is filthy throughout the day.
- Ms. Hislop asked Ms. Sealy to email her the complaint so she can discuss it with Success Academy administration and see if there can be some resolution.
