

<b>NOTES:</b>	<p><b>1/19 SLT meeting notes</b></p> <p>Read and accept minutes- 4 attendees</p> <p><b>Stakeholder and committee report:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Mid year visit from superintendent completed.</li> <li>● Ms. Hislop stated that she is always studying the quality review and principal rubrics to ensure that our school is hitting every mark.</li> <li>● It was noted that our school has many good practices and systems in place but the test scores are low. It is thought by outsiders that the problem must lie with instruction.</li> <li>● Ms. Hislop stated that she has enlisted various resources to support instruction and to support the school. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Consultants from Generation Ready for ELA and math.</li> <li>- Asked Eureka to send a consultant for feedback in math</li> <li>- Superintendent team to provide support</li> <li>- Highered a second grade teacher</li> <li>- Placed Ms. PC-Byrd back into the position as developer to work with upper grade in connecting the gap between coaches and stakeholders</li> <li>- Brought in new experts</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Ms. Hislop also shared that she is working on getting Quality Stars 3k and Pre-k resources. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- New York cares to provide a sensory pathway in the Pre-k corridor</li> <li>- Working on improving the teacher's lounge</li> <li>- Thinking of planning more trips, possibly out of state for exposure (NJ, Philly)</li> <li>- Thinking of providing students participating in the Disney play an opportunity to go to a Broadway show.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Ms. Hislop stated that she has secured a partnership with an area restaurant, allowing 40 students each month to have a sit down meal at the restaurant. (donors)</li> <li>● Ms. Pazol stated that a parent liked PS 59 and how the school is conducted. She stated that she is looking into resources for parents. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- CDL licensing</li> <li>- Security training and jobs</li> <li>- Home health aide</li> <li>- GED classes- she has partnered with an agency/ group to do virtual classes. Ms. Pazol and Mr. Figueroa are scheduled to meet with them on Monday.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Ms. Pazol stated that she has secured supplies for PS 59 students and is working on a way to get them to Brooklyn.</li> <li>● Holiday show was discussed- A huge turnout from families!</li> </ul>	

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|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Ms. Hislop stated that she is still working on an official date for the parent in the classroom event discussed previously.</li><li>● <b>New Business</b>- Discussed CEP district goals and looked at mid year data.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- ELA goal- Proficient move up 12% by June &gt; mid year data showed that there was a 16% jump in proficiency</li><li>- Math goal- started at 2%, increase to 11%&gt; almost met yearly goal</li></ul></li><li>● Ms. Hislop showed a slide that revealed grades 3 &amp; 4 are making 90-91% typical growth but not enough growth to show proficiency. Our students are way behind other students. Ms. Hislop stated that we are paying for consultants to leverage and doubling up to make sure students make growth.</li><li>● We are having consultants and others with expertise to take our progress to another level.</li></ul> |
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
